# NCAA Officiating Review Project

---

- The NCAA engaged *The PICTOR Group* to lead a comprehensive review of the state of collegiate officiating for 15 NCAA sports across all three divisions:
  - Basketball, Baseball, Field Hockey, Football, Gymnastics, Ice Hockey, Lacrosse, Soccer, Softball, Swimming & Diving, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball, Wrestling, Water Polo
- National review is underway and involves significant data collection
- Commissioners representing Divisions I, II and III comprise an *Officiating Review Steering Committee* to guide and oversee the project
- Final report to be submitted to NCAA in August 2020



# Data Collection

---

- Secure industry data currently available
- January – National survey to conference coordinators/assignors
- February – National survey to active/inactive/potential NCAA officials
- Ongoing – Interviews & focus groups with various stakeholders
  - NCAA staff, national/regional coordinators
  - Conference commissioners, coordinators
  - Officiating organizations (NASO, ArbiterSports, Officially Human, etc.)
  - Education-based organizations (NFHS, NAIA, NJCAA, NIRSA, etc.)
